Shahid's story in Saudi Arabia

“ When I arrived, my passport was taken from me and I was told I was going to be a shepherd, not work in the job I was promised. I protested – I was educated and trained – but my employer said things had changed, then he ‘gave’ me to someone else.

I lived out in the desert, in a shed with a tarpaulin roof. I was given basic food, it was not enough. It was some

rice, dahl, also the same food as the animals, animal fodder. I was not allowed to leave the farm. He took my passport. I couldn't go anywhere without it. Luckily, I met a worker from India nearby – he leant me his phone and I messaged my family for help.

I didn't get any wages at all. I had mortgaged my farm land for this.
